RESPONSIBLE TO: Management Committee

MAIN DUTIES:

- Ensure Academy compliance with the EB child protection, safeguarding and welfare policies.
- Be the first point of contact for the ~~OW~~ for child protection, safeguarding and welfare issues.
- Ensure that their own personal welfare training is compliant with EB requirements.
- Ensure that all relevant Academy members have DBS disclosures.
- Be a member of the ~~OW~~ Management Committee and ensure child protection is a priority for the ~~OW~~.
- Maintain a good communication link with the Regional Welfare Officer.
- Be aware of and have contact details of the local children services, Police Child Protection and NSPCC.
- Have displayed prominently in the ~~OW~~ the Child Protection Policy, CWO contact details, and the Code of Conduct
- An understanding of confidentiality and information sharing issues.
